Many of you will have noticed the recent presence of parking wardens outside school, at morning drop off time. We have been informed by Camden Council that, contrary to my letter sent to parents on the first day of term, the parking dispensation scheme has been discontinued. Officially, parking is only permitted for 3 minutes, although Camden Council have advised that a '*10-minute observation period has been introduced which should allow sufficient time for those who do drive to escort children into or from the building.*' May I please also remind you that parking in the disabled bay in Greencroft Gardens is not allowed at any time, unless you are a blue badge holder.

Please do continue to use the parking notice we have provided for you to put in your car, as this may help. I apologise for the added stress that these new arrangements may cause. I understand that other schools in the area are experiencing a similar increased presence of parking wardens.
