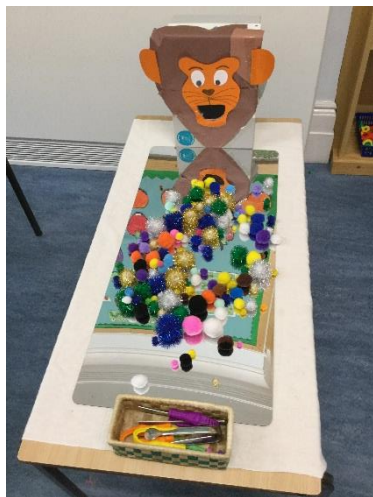
Children's quotes of the day-
