We have had a wonderful week in Class 4! This week we have been learning all about the farm. The children had an opportunity to discuss their favourite farm animals, learn some farm-themed songs and decorate farm animals using a range of crafts.

The children were excited to milk the cow and enjoyed exploring our small world sensory tray. We have been taking a close look at what animals live on the farm and how the farmer takes care of them.
