



# SPOTLIGHT OF THE WEEK Fire Station Visit

This week, the Nursery classes enjoyed an exciting and educational visit to West Hampstead Fire Station as part of their topic on "People Who Help Us". The children had the opportunity to learn about the important role of firefighters in keeping our communities safe.

During the visit, the children explored the fire engine, tried using the water hose, learned about the different tools and equipment, and even sounded the fire alarm. A particularly memorable moment was witnessing the firefighters being called out to a real emergency, bringing to life the vital and immediate nature of their work.

Back in the classroom, the children have been engaging in discussions about the wider emergency services and how people in our communities help in times of need. They've been sharing ideas on how to solve different problems, such as what to do if a cat is stuck in a tree, encouraging problem-solving and empathy.

#### **This Week in Action**

#### Little Learners

This week, the Little Learners class engaged in a creative printing activity using broccoli, exploring texture, shape, and colour through this sensory art experience. They also took part in discussions about their favourite foods, encouraging language development. In addition, the children participated in a variety of singing sessions featuring well-loved songs such as The Muffin Man, Apples and Bananas, and Twinkle Twinkle. Singing is a powerful and engaging tool that supports early phonics development. Through rhymes, actions, and rhythm, children develop an awareness of sounds, syllables, and patterns in language.

#### **Pre-Nursery**

In Pre-Nursery, the children have been exploring the theme of Spring and learning about the lifecycle of a plant. They have planted beans, taken responsibility for watering the classroom plants, and engaged in thoughtful discussions about what plants need in order to grow. These hands-on experiences nurture curiosity, responsibility, and an appreciation for nature. As part of their creative work, the children produced beautiful floral designs by pressing daisies, pansies, and roses into paper using wooden hammers.
