Little Learners

Little Learners have been busy bringing stories to life by pretending to be different characters and acting them out using words and dramatic actions. They are beginning to remember many simple stories and are enjoying listening to and joining in with these tales. Recently, they created fantastic shields and coats of arms to use while playing in the pretend castle they painted. In Maths, the children have been exploring how to represent numbers using their hands and fingers, developing their early number skills.



Pre-Nursery

Pre-Nursery have been learning about symmetry and symmetrical patterns by making beautiful butterflies, folding and pressing painted wings to create the effect. They have also been observing real insects, including ants, stick insect eggs, and ladybird larvae, patiently watching them grow and change. The children have loved singing minibeast-themed songs, such as "There's a tiny caterpillar on a leaf." They enjoyed a fun trip to Soft Play at the Sheriff Centre, where they climbed, slid, rolled, and jumped through different play areas. Classes 5 and 6 also had an exciting dance lesson from the Alyssia Fleur School of Dance.

Nursery children have been practising their concert, *Giraffes Can't Dance*, while learning all about animals and their habitats. They've made lovely crafts and hats in preparation for next week's performance and are excited to share their work.
