Thank you once again – wishing you a restful and happy weekend.

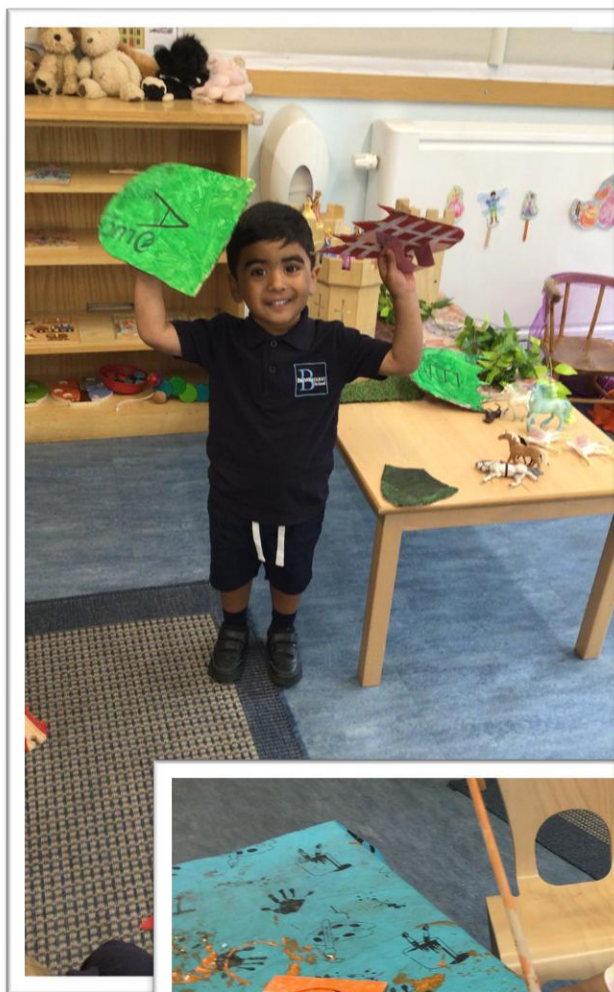

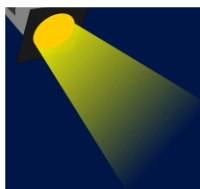


Nursery

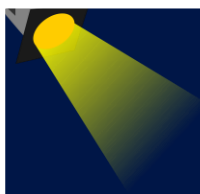


SPOTLIGHTS OF THE WEEK

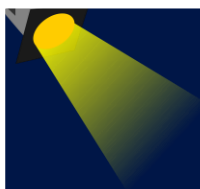




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Summer Concert
