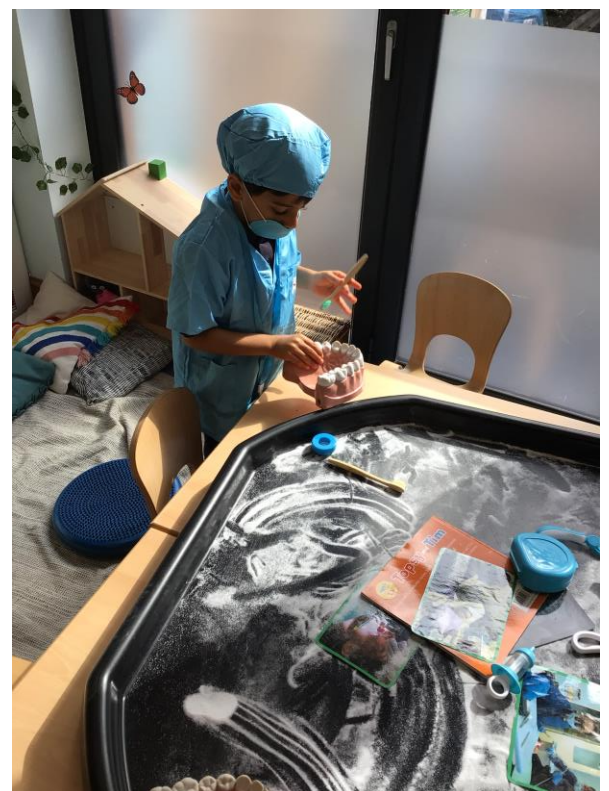


Pre Nursery children have had a fun week with lots of arts and crafts and plenty of songs. They have been learning their numbers and matching numbers to quantities up to three. They have been listening to the story of the colour monster and talking about their feelings. They are making wonderful progress with packing their own bags and being independent.





Nursery Children have been busy learning about keeping healthy and the importance of brushing teeth. They explored problem solving activities such as sorting foods into groups of either “good for teeth” and “treats” and playing games like Odd One Out.
